Sewer Project Update:

B&L Agreement Amendment was approved by REDI.

• DEC comments have been received on the Memo. B&L will respond.

Water Project Update:

Activity Completed in Last Month and Current Activities

- o WD Malone shutdown for the winter on January 15th.
- Approximately 63,000 LF of water main has been installed. This is approximately 42% of the total length.
- o Approximately 360 services have been installed. This is approximately 61% of the total
- Payment Application No. 6 has been disbursed to WD Malone. Payment Application No.
 7 has been submitted.
- Railroad Crossing No. 3 (County Route 28 in Richland) was attempted and failed twice using conventional bore method due to unforeseen ground conditions. WD Malone submitted a price adjustment request to cover the cost of these two attempts. This is \$26,000 more than the original bid price. This bore can be attempted using a different method (directional drill) for approximately \$49,000. B&L recommends loop be completed. Contingency funds will be available after State Comptroller Approval.
- Project Financing
 - o Coordination with EFC, RD, and Fiscal Advisors continues.
 - State Comptroller Application was submitted December 23rd and is currently in review.
- Steps to Proceed
 - o Construction Restart April 2021
 - o Construction Completion Spring 2022
