CALL TO ORDER:

Deputy Supervisor Ruth E. Scheppard called the meeting to order at 7:01 pm with the Pledge of Allegiance.

FINANCIAL REPORT:

The Town Board received a copy of the monthly financial report of the Supervisor tonight. It was filed in the Town Clerk's office and is available for public inspection.

REPORTS: Written reports were received from the Assessor, Dog Control Officer, Historian, Justices, Code Enforcement Officer and Planning Board.

<u>Library</u>- Director Jessica Godfrey presented the latest newsletter to the Town Board. The library is quite busy lately as a Pokémon GO gym. The exterior painting is done. It was noted that the columns at the front entrance are speckled and rust stained.

<u>Code Enforcement Officer</u> – John Howland's building permit and violation reports for July are on file in the Town Clerk's office. The letter from Oswego County Health Department regarding the Casey property was discussed.

<u>Water Advisory Committee</u> – Chairman Norma Newman reported that there were approximately 100 people at the Water District #3 informational session on Sunday, August 7th at the Elms Restaurant.

<u>Legislator</u> – Margaret Kastler did not stay for the meeting as the Oswego County Fair parade was in progress. She listed several items for Town Clerk Miller to report as

follows: After many meetings, the James A. FitzPatrick Nuclear Power Plant will not close. Exelon, the owner of the Nine Mile Point Nuclear Generating Station, will purchase it and assume operation. This was made possible largely due the adoption of the Clean Energy Standard by the NYS Public Service Commission. The City of Oswego has been awarded \$10 million from the Governor for downtown revitalization. The Oswego County Legislature will meet August 11th at 2 pm at the H. Douglas Barclay Courthouse in Pulaski. Camp Zerbe in Williamstown will receive \$100,000 thanks to Senator Patty Ritchie.

<u>Town Clerk</u> – Tammy Miller reported that receipts and total disbursements for the month of July totaled \$2,232.53. This report was filed with Supervisor Ridgeway on August 2nd and is on file in her office and available for public inspection. Hunting and trapping licenses for next season went on sale on August 1st.

PUBLIC COMMENT – Norma Newman suggested that the town look into funding from the Department of State Division of Cemeteries for the cleaning of 250 stones in the Stevens Cemetery.

OLD BUSINESS – The idea of having a volunteer or paid court clerk was again discussed. There was no action on this at this meeting. Supervisor Ridgeway wrote the letter of support and signed the application for the library grant last month. Invitations were received from the Cable Trail VFW Auxiliary for their POW-MIA recognition dinner on September 16th.

NEW BUSINESS - A verbal quote was received from Artisan Engraving for the cleaning of 250 stones at Stevens Cemetery. This was tabled until the board checks on the possibility of funding from the Division of Cemeteries. Notice was received from Williamson Law Book Company that their fees on software support contracts will increase 2% in January 2017. The Town of Sandy Creek purchased a new Bush Hog SM60 Side Mounted Rotary Cutter for a gross total delivered price of \$8,695.94 from Lakeland Equipment in June of 2010. Superintendent Kastler recently placed it on the Auctions International website and a bid for approximately \$6,000 has been received. **RESOLUTION 88-16**
