Sewer Project Update:

- Interest survey –Sewer survey was sent out end of July. Extra surveys are on file with Town Clerk Tammy Miller, sometimes they get lost in the mail.
 - 795 Respondents – approx. 32% of total mailed out
 - 226 Yes (28.4%)
 - 569 No (71.6%)
- Slideshow from Public Information Meetings was sent to the Town Water Clerk to be put online.

Water Project Update:

- Current Activity
 - Survey drawings are being put together, estimated completion end of this week – once B&L receives computer files from Surveyor we can begin layout/design.
 - Archaeological–Planning to be in the field 1 or 2 days this week weather dependent.
 - Soil Borings – CME Associates, Inc. –Boring locations staked out last week, drilling started on Tuesday, August 14.
 - Environmental Site Reviews – nearly complete. Permit application milestone – Early Fall.
- Project Financing
 - August 1st closing on Bond Anticipation Note (BAN).
 - DWSRF Application submitted in June. Typically takes a few months after they receive the application. BAN will be rolled into Interest Free Short Term Financing through EFC once approved this Fall.
 - Application for Water Infrastructure Improvement Act (WIIA) Grant will be re-submitted this year – up to \$3M Grant possible. Deadline – September 7th.



Water Project Update (cont'd):

- USDA Rural Development financing application submitted. B&L is coordinating Environmental items.
 - Potential for alternative financing and additional grant.
- Steps to Proceed
 - Engineering Design
 - Easement parcel title search
 - Obtain easements
 - Design completion
 - Regulatory Review / Permitting
 - Bidding
 - TARGET Construction Start - Summer 2019
