The meeting was called to order at 6:02 PM by Chairman Norma Newman with the Pledge of Allegiance.

Approval of August 29, 2016 minutes. Motion by Roy Narish seconded by Pat McDougal, all in favor.

Public Comment:

Mike Kastler, Highway & Water Superintendent, gave an update on the Water Districts. As a precaution, Water District #2 required a boil water advisory due to the Village of Sandy Creek replacing a valve on Main Street. The advisory has since been lifted.

Dustin Clark addressed the public regarding proposed Water District #3. The floor was then opened for questions from the public.

Mr. Maalouf is very much in favor of WD#3 as his road missed out on WD#1. Kevin Hurd also expressed his interest in WD#3 on Co Rt 62. Mr. Masuicca stated his opinions towards WD#3, he is not in favor. Jim Holden expressed his dire need of public water to his home on Co Rt 62. Mr. Holden stated that he cannot even fill his bath tub using his well and pump. There were a few questions regarding connecting to the water system. The Water Clerk has a list of contractors in the area. This list can be used to get actual quotes for installing water connections from the road to the residence.

Eric Pappa – Town of Sandy Creek Water Operator: Water testing is completed on the third Friday of each month. No other chemicals are added to the water besides chlorine. Richlands water is 1st in the county. Kevin Hurd added that Richlands water is first in the region, and third in the state. Richlands water source comes from multiple wells in Richland.

Yes, you can still use your well but there cannot be any cross connections with the municipal water supply. If your well is contaminated and connects with the water system that creates a health risk to everyone in the water district. Norma Newman explained that her well on her property is still used to water her lawn, wash cars, etc. Greene Point Road is on the proposed

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draft map. Leanne Alford, who has a farm, on Upton Road expressed her need for public water. She trucks in water daily to her property. Leanne has four wells three of which are sulfur.
