



## **FINANCIAL REPORT:**

The Town Board received a copy of the monthly financial report of the Supervisor tonight. It was filed in the Town Clerk's office today and is available for public inspection.

## **REPORTS:**

Assessor – Rhonda Weigand's report is on file in the Town Clerk's office and available for public inspection. Supervisor Ridgeway reported that the 2017 Tentative Assessment roll will be picked up tomorrow and on May 1<sup>st</sup> the change notices will be mailed. The first Tuesday in June is Grievance Day in Sandy Creek, June 6<sup>th</sup> this year.

Dog Control Officer- Elisa Dunn was absent this evening.

Historian – Charlene Cole's monthly report is on file in the Town Clerk's office and available for public inspection. Supervisor Ridgeway reported that the Historian has been contacted by a researcher from the A&E Network Family in Canada. They are doing a documentary on cheese and want material on Colonial Meacham's Big Cheese. The program will be aired in Canada and internationally.

Town Justice- The judges' reports for March have been received by the Town Supervisor.

Legislator – Margaret Kastler reported that the Underwater Marine Sanctuary application has been sent to the federal government for review. Designation is likely as this area has over 300 shipwrecks. Fort Ontario and the Safe Haven Museum, where Jewish immigrants stayed during WW II, have been nominated as National Parks. Tire Amnesty Days are May 13<sup>th</sup> and June 17<sup>th</sup> from 8 am to noon. Residents can take up to 8 regular size tires to the Pulaski transfer station those days. More room is needed at the county jail. A committee has been formed to look at the possibility of a new building or adding on to the current building. The Oswego County Legislature will meet on April 13<sup>th</sup> at 7 pm in the Legislative Chambers in Oswego.

Library- Director Jessica Godfrey presented the Town Board with her monthly newsletter. A \$500 grant was received and the Kids Corner make-over is complete. An Easter egg hunt will be held April 15<sup>th</sup> and a book folding tutorial is scheduled for April 18<sup>th</sup>. Children age 4 to 18 are encouraged to register for the Lego Competition on April 22<sup>nd</sup>. Resume and cover letter assistance is available on Tuesdays from 2 to 3 pm. Miss Godfrey would like to have the carpets cleaned in May and again in the fall. Supervisor Ridgeway and Pat McDougal complimented Miss Godfrey on the variety of fun activities for kids available at the library.

NOCA- The quarterly report of Northern Oswego County Ambulance has been received and filed in the Town Clerk's office.

Planning Board – Chairman Shirley Rice read the report from the Sandy Creek Regional Planning Board's meeting on April 4<sup>th</sup>. A site plan for a solar farm in the village has been received from High Peaks Solar, LLC. Councilman Warner asked about possible toxins in solar panels and about the life expectancy of the panels. CEO Howland will get the specifications on the panels. Mr. Warner would like to consider adding hazardous materials disposal to our local solar law.

Highway/Water Superintendent – Michael C. Kastler read his highway report. He placed 3 one-way plows, a 10' dump box off a 2005 truck, a 15' dump box, and two tailgates on the Auctions International website.
