CALL TO ORDER:

Deputy Supervisor Ruth Scheppard called this special meeting to order at 6:02 pm with the Pledge of Allegiance. She then turned the meeting over to Dustin Clark, P.E., Senior Project Engineer for Barton & Loguidice. This special meeting was held to discuss the optional areas in proposed Water District #3.

Dustin Clark started by discussing the draft map and optional areas. A lengthy discussion followed.

PUBLIC COMMENT:

At this time Dustin Clark opened the meeting for questions. There was a question about the water mains and how soon water will be available to property owners. If funding is approved on the first try, which is not common, water mains may be installed as early as two years from now. Water interest on Whitney Lane was discussed. How can property owners express that they are or are not interested in receiving public water? Property owners may contact the Town Clerk or Water Clerk with their contact information and

they will record your information on the interest lists. Property owners do not have to connect to the water system. However, you will still be charged on your January tax bill. The Town's water supply for Water District #1 comes from the Schoeller well fields. The water is treated with chlorine, to kill any bacteria that may grow. Our water is tested frequently. Water equipment for Water District #3 will likely be available for purchase once the project is underway. Water equipment can be purchased at the Town Hall, with the Water Clerk. Properties will be returned to same or better condition after construction. Property owners are responsible for installation from their home to the curb stop. Water District #1 property owners had one year to connect to the water system without connection fees. After that year a \$500 fee was charged to have a curb stop installed.

Dustin Clark continued discussing the optional sections with the Town Board and Water Advisory Committee.

On motion by Ruth Scheppard, seconded by Nola Gove. and carried unanimously, the meeting was adjourned at 8:50 pm.
